Assisted Living Centers – as many members actually live there

Rose O’Neill Museum  
Police Building – tour and sharing of vital self-protection information  
Ambulance/EMT Building – tour and sharing of vital life-saving information  
Health Centers – tour and sharing of vital health information  
Hospitals – tour and sharing of special services  
Arrow Rock – play and meeting  
Vandalia Women’s Prison – tour and meeting  
Greenhouse
