By:

- Encouraging all local units to have an IPS Committee chairperson and for them to arrange for IPS programs or handouts at each unit meeting. In addition, information can be disbursed through phone calls, written and electronic communications.
- 2) Monitoring the MRTA website, IPS page, and social media, such as Facebook, for new activities and reports that may be shared at local unit meetings.
- 3) Participating in October's National Cyber Security Month as a statewide IPS project.
