## **MRTA Legislative Committee Goals and Duties 2023**

CHARGE:

To encourage MRTA members to work actively for beneficial legislation so all public school employees and retirees may live healthy, vital lives, and be secure economically, socially, and professionally.

## **Objectives:**

- 1. Promote MRTA membership to active and retired educators and support staff.
- 2. Encourage all local units to have a legislative committee chairperson to promote and report on legislative updates at all MRTA unit meetings.
- 3. Mobilize support "MRTA Call to Action" and "Phone2Action" among your unit members for MRTA's positions regarding legislation and other advocacy issues.
- 4. Encourage participation in the MRTA Legislative Day/Capitol Blitz Day.
- 5. Communicate the importance of a strong response by unit members to their own elected officials.
- 6. Encourage members to know their elected officials and to also consider running for office.
- 7. Encourage MRTA units to host a candidate forum.
- 8. Encourage elected officials to attend MRTA Regional Meetings.
- 9. Establish a good working relationship and rapport with elected officials, their staff, and other key figures in government.
- 10. Become knowledgeable about the legislative process, and the most effective means of participating in that process.
- 11. Alert the Legislative Committee Chair or MRTA Executive Director to any new legislative developments you encounter in the course of your work.
- 12. Increase MRTA membership by communicating the need for "Strength in Numbers."
